Do you have concerns about your child's:

- development?
 - Are they hitting age-appropriate developmental milestones (on average, rolling at 3 mo., sitting at 6 mo., crawling at 9 mo., walking at 12 mo.)?
- posture?
 - Do they hold their head turned to one side or tilted? Does the child lean to the side or constantly need support?
- sensory processing?
 - Do they seek sensory input by bumping into things? Do they avoid sensory input or fuss when touching textures? Can they self-soothe and calm?
- possible drug or alcohol exposure in the womb?
