## A NOTE FROM THE Executive Director

This past year has posed many new and unexpected challenges for children and families. In 2020, divorce rates increased, families faced financial difficulties and relational strain, while kids had to navigate distance learning or transition to home schooling. Reports of child abuse went down yet in all likelihood the number of abusive situations spiked.

In order to rise to the occasion and meet the needs of foster youth, single parents, and struggling families, our team needed a fresh approach. As inperson events were canceled, we quickly transitioned to online workshops, conferences and collaborative meetings. As food insecurity and the need for support escalated in families, so did the generosity of our community.

I have watched in awe as individuals, families, and organizations have worked together in unity to protect kids and strengthen families in 2020 like never before. We truly are better together!





The Training UP Conference is an annual event for anyone wanting to provide trauma-informed care for children. This event includes resources for parents, social workers, & educators.



Our custom church ministry coaching program equips faith based leaders to successfully come alongside vulnerable children & families in their congregation & community.





Just launched in 2020, these online courses taught by leaders in the field are a FREE resource for foster & adoptive parents and providers.



This annual event is hosted for local agency, nonprofit and community leaders to celebrate the working being done to support vulnerable children & families while enhancing collaboration between organizations.



Our team of certified Trust Based Relational Intervention trainers help caregivers and providers connect with kids from hard places through this 30-hour course offered twice annually.



This collective campaign, also launched in 2020, invites community members to make a difference for local kids & families in need with over 20 ways to get involved from giving gifts to becoming a foster parent.


## **UPDATES & NEW RESOURCES COMING IN 2021**
